AGE CATEGORIES

Category A "Premiere" Competitors up to 13 years.

A1: 5-7 years. A2: 8-10 years. A3: 11-13 years.

Category B "Junge Talente" Competitors up to 17 years.

Category C "Junge Meister" Competitors up to 35 years.

REPERTOIRE

REPERTOIRE CATEGORY A "Premiere":

The Competition for Category A will take place in one round.

A1: 2-5 Min. A2: 2-5 Min. A3: 2-10 Min.

• The Program chosen by the candidate.

REPERTOIRE CATEGORY B "Junge Talente":

The Competition for **Category B** will take place in **one round**. The total playing time must amount to at least 15 minutes but must not exceed 20 minutes.

- One virtuoso Etude by Chopin, Liszt, Debussy, Rachmaninov, Scriabin, Strawinsky.
- One or more pieces chosen by the candidate.

REPERTOIRE CATEGORY C "Junge Meister":

The Competition for **Category C** will take place in two rounds.

First Round: 15 minutes.

- One virtuoso etude by Chopin.
- One virtuoso etude by Liszt, Debussy, Rachmaninov, Strawinsky, Scriabin, Ligeti.
- One piece chosen by the candidate.

Final Round: 55-60 minutes.

- The first movement of a sonata by Haydn, Mozart, Clementi, Beethoven.
- One or more pieces chosen by the candidate.

1st Prize : € 3000

(Concerts in Germany, Paris or China)

^{*} The concert prize can also be awarded to the 2nd or 3rd prize. This is subject exclusively to the decision of the jury.

For the 4th Prize, 5th Prize and 6th Prize winner.

1st Prize: € 500 | **2nd Prize**: € 200 | **3rd Prize**: € 100

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

• The competition is open to pianists of all nationality until **35** years old.

- All music must be performed from memory.
- All stages of the competition are open to the public.
- When a price has not been given the prize money will not distributed to the other prices.
- The copyright for all audio, video and photos during the competition belongs to the competition organizer.
- All finalists must be present at the prize winners' concert on **August 04, 2024**. An unexcused absence from this concert equivalent to give up the prize money. The performers take place at the winners' concert without a fee.
- Changes of the date of the competition because of objective reasons belongs to the organizer.
- By sending the registration document you agree to the rules of the competition.
- Participants who are unable to participate in the draw on **August 01, 2024** and have not previously reported this to the Organizing Committee cannot participate in the competition.
- The list of names with winners from categories A and B will be announced and published on **August 3, 2024**. There is no publication before this date.
- Decisions taken by the Board of Examiners may not be appealed.
- In the case of translation-related disagreements the German text of these regulations is essential.
- There is no right of appeal.
